
Develop the skills and connections to serve your entire career.

MACT students may complement their primary coursework by choosing an elective from the university's MBA program. For hands-on experience, students can complete an internship (and earn academic credit) through the Accounting program's close relationships with CPA firms as well as business and government organizations. Finally, the department hosts an annual Accounting Student Retreat, where students meet with professionals, discuss career opportunities and exam preparation, and engage with fellow students in an informal setting.

The intentional design of this program translates directly into success for our students. Our pass rates for the CPA exam rank us among the top schools in Texas. We also have an outstanding reputation among Big Four firms, regional firms and local firms in Austin, all of whom specifically recruit our graduates.
